The Wright brothers brought the era of Aviation to America. They were Wilbur and Orville Wright and were the first people to make an air flying machine. Wilbur Wright was born on April 16, 1867, near Millville, Indiana and Orville Wright was born in Ohio on August 19, 1871. The Wright brothers were American inventors and pioneers of aviation. In 1903 they achieved the first powered airplane flight. Two years later, they broke their record when they built and flew the first fully practical airplane.


